## Technical Information

Flexipel EC-40 is a concentrate designed to provide a water based enhancer that delivers results similar to the solvent based products that dominate this segment today. At recommended use rate, Flexipel EC-40 makes a water based enhancer (with only 3% VOC) that when applied correctly seals and protects the stone while also bringing out the color in dull or chalky surfaces, and without delivering the glossy shine that polishing the surface would accomplish.

## FORMULARY

Flexipel EC-40 is a ready to dilute concentrate. Simply add four parts Flexipel EC-40 to six parts water, and mix well. The product settles upon storage, so this ready to apply formula should be clearly labeled "mix well before use." The photos below illustrate the darkening effect on slate (left) and tumbled marble (right).
